

PROCEDURE AND ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR THE FOREIGN STUDENTS

Admission requirements

For admission to the courses leading to a Ph. D degree a candidate

- a) must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 out of 5.00 or a first division or equivalent in any one of SSC and HSC or in equivalent examinations and must not have a GPA less than 2.00 out of 5.00 or a third division or equivalent in any of the aforementioned examinations.
- b) must have at least 50% marks or a minimum GPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent in four- year BA or B.Sc degree/B.Sc Engg./M.A or M.Sc or MSS/B.Arch./ BURP in the relevant branch.
- c) must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 out of 4.00 or its equivalent in M.Sc Engg./M.Engg./M.Phil/ MURP/M.Arch./M.Sc(WRD)/MBA degree in the relevant branch.

For admission to the courses leading to a M.Sc/M.Engg./M.Arch./MURP and M.phil Degree a candidate

- a) must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 out of 5.00 or a first division or equivalent in any one of SSC and HSC or in equivalent examinations and must not have a GPA less than 2.00 out of 5.00 or a third division or equivalent in any of the aforementioned examinations.
- b) must have at least 50% marks or a minimum GPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent in four-year BA or B.Sc degree/B.Sc Engg./M.A or M.Sc or MSS/B.Arch./ BURP in the relevant branch.

Procedure for submission of application:

Direct application for admission can not be entertained. Students must apply through Government channel along with transcripts of full academic records and also enclosing a ‘no objection certificate’ from his/her employer. Application for admission must be submitted through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of Bangladesh. Application form may be collected from the Bangladesh High Commission office/Embassy in the respective country and to submit in the same office.

Total credit hours and cost of study:

A foreign student has to pay US\$50 per credit hour as tuition fees. The students of SAARC countries will fall under the category of local students’ tuition fees. A Ph.D student will have to complete 54 credit hours, 48 credit hours for M. Phil students and 36 credit hours for M.Sc./M. Engineering students. No Scholarship is available for the foreign students.

Other information:
